My thoughts on each short story

THIS REVIEW DOES HAVE SPOILERS!!! But, if you've read the ENTIRE Fallen series, you have nothing to worry about.

What Happened to Trevor: Finally. Finally. Finally! I was beginning to think that we were never going to get the full story. Luce vaguely told what happened, but now I am glad the mystery is put to rest.

Arriane's Day Out: I love Arriane. I think she's an awesome kick-ass character. I loved her since Fallen. But, what I love even more is Arriane and Roland together. They have such a great friendship, especially since they both are on opposing sides. You know, there are two types of Fallen angels. Some are on the good side with the hopes of returning to heaven (Arianne) and others are on the dark side because they don't agree with heaven's rules (Roland). It takes a strong friendship to endure something like that.

It was nice to see how excited Arriane was about Luce returning. Since I know how Arianne actually feels about Luce coming back and reuniting to Daniel, this just makes me want to read the first book again. Now that I've read the series in its entirety, maybe there were some things I didn't notice/understand then that makes a lot more sense now. I can't wait to read that series again. **Also, this was my favorite story out of this little companion book.**

*Plus, they mentioned Luce's favorite flower, no matter what time period she's in. Aren't these lovely?! (White Peonies)

Daniel in L.A: I really don't have much to say about this story. This story deals with the first time that Daniel and Shelby met. You know, when she made it known to Luce that she was "with" Daniel during the time period he was waiting for Luce's return. Nothing happened between Daniel and Shelby, of course. In fact, what Shelby told Luce in Torment is what made me really dislike her. I never liked her after that, even when she did finally come clean about how nothing really happened.

Miles in the Dark: I didn't too much care for this story. I don't too much care for Mile's and Shelby's relationship, either.

Inside Francesca's Office: This was a very short story, and I don't think it really brought anything to the original series. This was just Meh.

Cam Goes Hunting: Cam, another one of my favorites! In all honesty, I liked the majority of the characters in this series.

This story deals with Cam fighting that outcast at Shoreline. I didn't think there was much more to that storyline, but apparently so.

Also, I have a question. I always thought that in *Fallen*, once it was revealed who Cam Briel really was, that he was leading Luce on the entire time. But, maybe I'm wrong? Did he actually at one point have feelings for her, or was he only after Luce to spite Daniel?

"You are spying on her." The girl jerked her blond head upward, toward the deck where—it was true—Lucinda was seated on a bench, looking striking in a rose-red sweater and her newly bleached hair. She was talking to some Nephilim friend, talking in the open, trusting way she used to talk to Cam. Her hazel eyes wide, her lips pursed with that old sadness. Cam could look at her all day.

"I'm protecting her from the likes of you," he spat. "There's a difference, baby, not that you'd be able to see it." He stole another glance at Luce.

"You will"—punch—"not"—knee snap—"get her."

The Outcast gagged as she coughed up one of her teeth and spat blood across Cam's T-shirt.

"Spoken like someone who never even had a chance."

He punched her again, right in the eye. "I did. You hear that, Outcast? I may have lost it, but I used to have a chance."

There are two ideas I get from this. 1) Cam is lonely and he misses how close Luce and him had gotten. Or, 2) at some point Cam really did fall for her, but just left it alone because he knew they would never happen. Either way, it's kind of sad. Poor Cam.

Luce and Daniel's Date: I don't know when this story took place. But either way, it didn't really add anything either to the original series. Sure, I love the interactions between Daniel and Luce. I love them together, but this was just lacking.
