She is penniless because her boyfriend cleaned her out. You listen to her venting about her bad luck with a lion she has named "King". Fiona shares her secrets and fantasies with King unaware to her that he is a real person. Throughout her diatribe you witness the lion reacting to her by either snorting or roaring at something she said that he did not like. Like when she tells King she is going out and getting laid with the first man she comes across. King goes ballistic and almost get Fiona fired.
