But there's more to this story than that. There's the healing of a father son relationship that may just make your eyes a little damp, one man's realization of what he really wants out of life, and one pretty great epilogue.

Here's my one complaint: I think the relationship needed to be developed further, which I realize is an unrealistic expectation with the time constraints in the writing event, but still. I couldn't help but feel like both Shane and Mason's reactions when everything came to light, were too intense for something so freshly new. Shane's rings a little more true. And yes, I know, Shane's been whacking it off to thoughts of Mason for years, but as far as we know, Mason hasn't been doing the same until he finally saw Shane all grown up. If they had been dating for a little while, it would have made a little more sense, especially when it came to Mason. I suppose since Shane's father had been talking up Shane to Mason for years, there's a chance that maybe he fell in love with Shane too? I guess what I'd like is a little more understanding of the depth of feelings on Mason's end of things.

What I really took away from this story, over the romance, was the healing of a father son relationship, which I wanted for them from the moment I read their first interaction. Overall this was a super sweet, adorable, well written, quick read.
