I read the first book, Linkage, and if you haven't you should as it really sets the stage nicely for this book.

Lucas shows us a different side of himself in this book and the book opens with a roar that is Lucas unleashed.

While Linkage gave us insight on Lucas and his relationship with his brother, Incursion showed us what one is capable of when pushed to his limit. Incursion was faster paced but I do think we needed the pace of the story in Linkage to get us to Incursion.

I liked the mention of the Akashic Field and also of Nikola Tesla. Seeing mention of Project Stargate smoothly worked into the story made me smile as the author has his finger on the pulse of what to add to give this story the extra layers that I enjoyed so much in Linkage.

I also liked the twists to what you thought was a given- only to find out the story takes a little jog to the left (or right). Without giving details, there is a part when Lucas is checking bodies and the great attention to detail that the author has shown in both books is apparent. We also see another example of that "jog in the road" that takes the story up a notch as it is unexpected.

While Jay J. Falconer proved his writing abilities in the first book, he really knocked the ball out of the park with Incursion.

This was a story that didn't have any lulls. While part of me wished Reversion was available now, having a little break is okay too. I definitely will be reading the third book in this series as soon as it is available.
