Insofar as the story, the class structure is organized on the basis of being alpha/beta/omega. However, what I found to be interesting is the way in which the rights of omegas in society are explicitly addressed. Though I am looking forward to more world building in the future (cant wait!), I found the descriptions of the literally hidden away and basically encaged lives of omegas in this society were quite interesting, especially because the society at large has accepted the caste system and its members aren't somehow drugged or misinformed as to their worth or value as betas or omegas.

Legion is a ruthless alpha and yet his cool attitude and the "I'm going to get what I want because you're going to give it to me" attitude throughout the story is unexpected. Though it is very clear that he desires Lanthe, readers can tell that his main priority is asserting his authority and maintaining his cool... I really hope we get to see Lanthe breaking through his cold resolve! With Legion's demeanor in mind, Lanthe's naive, innocent air contrasts starkly so as to make her moments of helplessness are all the more impactful. Ultimately, I was pleasantly surprised by this quick read and highly recommend to all omegaverse readers!
