The plot was certainly creative and the author definitely spun an interesting tale of a world of vampires, lycans, wizards plus Christianity. There was a lot going on in this book, and I liked how there was a wide cast of characters but sometimes the constant switching back and forth between the characters' POVs was a little confusing. My biggest complaint about the book is that it should have been edited more carefully - I did notice a lot of punctuation errors and POV inconsistencies and sometimes phrases were repeated.

Was this the best book I ever read? No. But it wasn't the worst, either. I would recommend this book if you are very religious and into gore and supernatural mythos.
