He's just biding his time until his parole is over and he can move on. But *Adrift* isn't just Ben's story, it's also Juniper's. And when Juniper enters Ben's life she's like a balm to his soul. Not to say it's all smooth sailing, because it's not. But even when they hit some rough waters, there's a connection between Ben and Juniper that they can't deny or hide from.

I adore Ben. He was a bit like a lost puppy, just wandering about with no direction until Juniper arrives.
