I really like Butcher's Sentinel War series, but this standalone alien romance just didn't click with me for some reason - I guess I just never fell for the leading man. I think that if there had been a better reason for the hero to make it home before his powers and his memory faded - one with more pathos - I might have liked it better. As it was, the hero just wasn't conflicted enough between his responsibility and his sudden feelings for the heroine to win me over. The heroine on the other hand does manage to stir some sympathy, she's loved and lost and is destined to loose again and I respected her willingness to accept that loss to do the right thing.

When all is said and done though, it is likely the real problem was the length of the story, this was fairly short and in order to fit a fair bit of steamy stuff in - and with short span of time that the pair were together - there just wasn't time to develop the emotional part of the connection between them.

This novella was not up to Shannon Butcher's usual standards, at least not in terms of her longer fiction, and it has almost convinced me to just stick with her regular fiction.

The premise is that Earth is a magic-free prison for an alien race. The longer the prisoners are here, the less they remember/resemble their own species. Toren witnessed the death of his sister by her husband, and that husband opened a portal, sending him to earth before he could do anything about it.

He arrives, Superman or Terminator style, in the front yard of Adria's rental cabin. There is instant, mutual lust.

It was predictable and uninspired. I can't even put a finger on why that was, maybe because it was so formulaic and yet so short. There wasn't a chance to really bond with the characters to feel what they felt for each other before they are jumping into bed together and declaring their tragic love for each other.

I like Butcher's Edge series and her Sentinels. I like her strong female characters that have opinions and disagreements with the alpha males. This heroine was neither strong nor opinionated. The plot was too simple, the solution even simpler.
