Too bad my boyfriend does not have – or even want – tattoos at all. But back to Kelly Gendron’s third book in her Trouble Maker series. All books of this series can be read as standalone – which is exactly what I did. Contemplating how much I liked this book I it is likely that I’ll read book #1 and #2 as well.

“Nobody is getting this Lucky.” Wow, what an arrogant self-absorbed asshole, having such a motto for life! Must be someone who has only love for himself. ...right? Well, not exactly, because Lucky has reasons acting like this, shoving everyone away who might care about him – but deep down, he is an affectionate, sensitive and caring guy: beautiful inside and out.

...and former child star Kayley is about to discover just that. Being tired of her “good girl”-image, she desperately wants to escape it, starting with a nice tattoo on her hip. When she gets in a quarrel with her drunken friend Marissa and the even more drunken tattoo artist who is currently working on her tattoo, the shop’s owner – Lucky – appears. Eventually he is the one who finishes Kaley’s tattoo, but not without leaving a very special mark on her hip. Never would he have thought that he has to see her again – that is until his cousin Sloan throws away the chit on which he noted down exactly what he worked into Kaley’s tattoo.

To add to Lucky’s trouble, Kaley is determined to use his “badass” to finally destroy her pure and white reputation irrevocably.

Both of them are in for a ride neither of them expected – or even wanted.

I loved both sides of Lucky – Lucky the badass O’Connor as well as Luke himself, his sweet and real side (...although I wouldn’t have minded if “badass” stayed a bit longer). The more time he spends with Kaley, the more the real Luke leaks through, without him even realizing it. Soon the original reason to get to Kaley takes a back seat and his motives begin to totter.

This is a sweet romantic story about a hot and sexy not so bad-assed tattooed guy finding his match in a sweet good girl who does not want to be that good. It is well-written, with absolutely likeable characters and has just the right amount of tension, suspense and emotion. Just wonderful!

So I guess y'all can tell that I have a new book boyfriend, huh? What gave me away? The raving about additional tats? Or maybe the fact that I could not put *Lucky Numbers* down? There's a song that goes "she's up all night to get lucky" and it totally applies in this situation. I was up wayyyyyyy past my bedtime reading this book and then up at the crack of dawn to finish it (although the baby may also have factored in my early rising time).

Lucky has plans. He already owns two successful tattoo parlors and he's about to expand his chain by two more. This is the third book *TroubleMaker* novel and each book is a standalone. Although I haven't read the first two books, I loved this one and would love to read the next one and any more in the series.

Luke O'Conner, aka Lucky, has everything a woman wants or needs. A loving family, his own business and a godly body. The problem is Lucky bares guilt from events that happened when he was a teenager and he can't move forward. While trying to remember the safety deposit vault numbers he'd had installed, he's distracted by one very high maintenance co-worker and a drunk woman in the shop and has no option but to go and investigate.

This inebriated woman just happens to be a Kaley's BFF. Kaley is having a tattoo done and because of the disturbance, he not only ends up tattooing her, but he also has to put things right since his co-worker screwed this young gal's tattoo up. There is an instant attraction between the two of them, so he flirts with her and she

flirts back knowing nothing will become of it. Or so he thinks until he realises he's made a dreadful mistake and he must find Kaley as she is the only one who has the answer.

Kaley was a successful child actress and struggling with her own events in her life, in her career and in her relationship with her mother. Even though she becomes rebellious, Kaley herself knows what she wants. She has a strong personality and has a best friend that every woman should have, too.

Lucky has no option but to find Kaley if he wants to get back what he inadvertently gave her. What is it you may ask? Well, not even she knows what it is and the only way to find out is by reading this story with a brilliant and fast-moving plot.
