Patrick also has found a way to leash the rabids, vampires that have become sick because of the void. Patrick is systematically destroying all life on the planet and that included other vampires. While Marcus had gone to fight the rabids, his strong hold was attacked and destroyed by Patrick. Marcus had been tricked into leaving the compound unprotected and the result was catastrophic. Marcus is the King of the Vampires and has found his true love in a human mate and he had left her behind at the compound.
