But this time there is a new wrinkle: the introduction and "live" appearance of a new sibling for Saati and Toni - Forty!! Forty's programming was scrambled during a fight between Saati and Toni, so Forty has characteristics that both wanted in a sibling. Only manifested as a split personality. Forty has a male persona AND a female persona. Both show up to cause new mayhem.
