In an interesting twist on necromancy, the Center raises the dead to come back as vampires, for a price, of course. Kristina Chase is a necromancer, a very powerful necromancer in the Creator category. Kris wants nothing to do with her necromancy. This has a lot to do with the fact Kris hears and sees ghosts seeking vengeance for their deaths at the hands of the creatures raised by the Center. So far, Kris has managed to find peace for these ghosts and help them move on, by killing the vampires that caused their deaths. The vampires Kris kills are your typical "evil" vampires. The Council of Necromancers has been after Kris for years to join them, specifically Rush Davis, leader of the Council. Despising them for raising vampires, creatures who, in her experience, do nothing but prey on humans, Kris refuses every time. Kris really knows little about her powers or how necromancing works. When Rush Davis calls again, Kris knows she might as well answer, because if she doesn't he will just come over, and she can't deal with her undeniable attraction to him, the enemy. This time though, he has different news for Kris that will throw her into a tailspin and start a chain of events that will see Kris forced to develop her necromancer powers and battling almost every evil creature you could think of, with a little help along the way. With a six foot resident ghost to bounce things off, a sister keeping secrets and Kris' new creation, the intriguing cast of characters keeps this book interesting right to the very action-packed ending. The paranormal world being created by the author is a refreshingly different. The sudden plot twists and abrupt changes in narratives will have your brain racing trying to keep up. Although not creating the smoothest reading experience, it is compelling. All in all, a good, solid start to what promises to be a very exciting new series.
