I personally wanted a bit more of the perspective of Bridget in the first book, but I guess I asked for too much considering this one exclusively flips the perspective to her. This in itself doesn't really have to be a negative, but reading from both perspective I am of the opinion that Bridget simply isn't a very interesting character, at the very least not compared to Natalia. As she always refers to Natalia as "you" throughout the book ("you" did this, "you" did that etc..") it almost feels like a journal/diary, so that even though it may be TOLD from Bridget's perspective, it still feels like the entire thing focuses on Natalia, without Bridget being able to quite shine as a strong character herself.

In the first book, Bridget on some levels came off as the stronger and more grounded character of the two (especially early on), so her stage of depression felt like a way to balance the characters seeing how "perfect" she had been before. Unfortunately in this book, Bridget really just comes off as a rather weak character compared to Natalia, with Natalia seemingly pulling almost all the way in the relationship.

I didn't really dislike it but I don't think it compares to the first book.
