Leanore Elliott's Newest release Beasts Of Forever Book 1 is her second three part series out this year. The unique concept of this story makes for a wild, exciting ride into the paranormal.

Constance Braddock is a troubled psychic. She has visions of the nasty kind with images of serial killers and their victims. She shows up at the scene of where she believes there will be a murder. There she meets Jack Wagner, a tough, rebel homicide detective. He shoots the killer where he stands.

This begins a three year partnership. Constance provides the killers. She "finds" them and Jack confronts them. The choice is given, the murderer can choose redemption. If the psycho refuses to give up his killing ways , Jack has their neat, little cemetery plot all picked out.

As if this arrangement and story is not unusual and surreal enough? Constance begins to have strange dreams, and visions (and not about serial killers.) She dreams of Jack, when he's always been just like a buddy to her. She begins to feel urges and feelings for him she's never felt before. She finally confronts this with him. We the readers are in for the biggest surprise when she finds out the truth.

This continuing story is full of erotic scenes between them and one that I call Ambrosia. This scene was like nothing I've ever read in a romance before. Using paranormal and sensual elements, the scene almost flies up at you from the pages. I will always want that type of "dinner" for myself.
