The Wood Boy was, quite literally, just 'okay', and so I can't conscientiously give it more than 2 stars. It's been years since I read the Riftwar novels, starting with Magician, and although I know I really enjoyed them I can't say what bearing this short story has on the novels. Does the character of Dirk appear again? I don't know. And on that strength I'm rating The Wood Boy wholly on its own merits. Feist is a great storyteller; that's inarguable, but it seems when he wrote this particular story his prose wasn't exactly top-notch. There are weak areas that could have shone if written with more show and less tell, but the story mostly plodded along, content to take us through several pages of unenthusiastic scenes. The story proper is wrapped (read: padded) in a couple of pages fore and aft in the PoV of Duke Borric; I suppose this was necessary for the 'reveal' at the end - which might have had more impact if it had been revealed not just to us, the readers, but to the character of Dirk. Didn't happen, and perhaps the story of the Wood Boy bears relevance later on, but without knowing either way I can only conclude that the short story is a not-unwasted time-filler, but certainly nothing that will leave a lasting impression.
