This short read had me hooked from start to finish. Serenity and Hope are sisters who have secrets in their past that may stop them enjoying the future. I liked that all the characters had their own voice and the structure was not the standard, traditional linear one, but the book went from present to past to present, which made the narrative more interesting (in my opinion). I think the editing could be tighter, and I was going to give this one 4 stars when I was in the middle of the book, however, I cried not once, but twice! When I read the last page, I had tears running down my cheeks, and any book that can do that to me gets 5 stars! If you like romance with a touch of erotica, I'd definitely recommend this one.

If you're looking for a quick read with some good sexually explicit content and minimal dialogue - A Splash of Hope would be right up your alley. However, if you're looking for a book with a story that makes sense - this is not the book for you.

As mentioned in the synopsis, the entire plot focuses on Faith trying to figure out why her sister left Adam (who also happens to be Faith's former lover) at the altar. The reasoning (not only of why she left but why they were even having a wedding in the first place) turns out to be completely nonsensical.

As mentioned, the author has the sex scenes written pretty well - and you can guess the outcome of the story five minutes into the book, so I have to assume the characters' storylines weren't intended to be important. However, since I like books with logic behind the characters' actions, I wasn't a fan of A Splash of Hope. To me, it reads sort of like the author wrote out various sex scenes and then tried to create a story to tie them all into one book.

Basically, A Splash of Hope would have rated higher had the storyline (and reasoning behind the characters' decisions) made more sense. The epilogue was my favorite part of the book (and I'm not saying that in a snarky "because I was so glad it was over" kind of way) because it sort of showed the potential for the characters as a whole - had the author taken time to flesh out the story. (It also gives readers an idea of how good a writer Charity Parkerson could be if she focused more on plot.)

It should also be added that A Splash of Hope is really more of a novella than a book - it is about 80 "real book" pages long - and you can read through it fairly quickly.

It is about a girl, Faith, who lost her parents and elder sister one fateful night and was left as guardian to her younger sister, Serenity. Luckily, if you can say that about a tragedy, Faith had just graduated high school and Serenity was 16, so she only had 2 more years of schooling to get through. This story takes place about seven years later. Faith receives a cryptic express mail message and is forced to return to her hometown to advise an expectant groom and wedding attendees that the bride is not coming, namely Serenity. This return to her hometown, that held mostly bad memories for her, and trying to find her missing sister is almost a catharsis for Faith. She is forced to face some truths that she didn't want to see when she was still reeling and grieving the loss of her parents, sister, and her youth. It re-introduces her to the one person she had a crush on in high school and an interesting interlude with one evening a few years later and who also happens to be the groom that was left at the altar.....

I think you would call this a novelette. Had it been printed in standard paperback print it would not have been the almost 200 pages that it was. It is an easy, fun read with some explicit sexual content but not overly done.
