arch-demon Asmodeus (spelled somewhat differently) not once, but twice, killing him is tough enough... but Cade has to deal with all his conflicting feelings dealing with his wife's body, which Asmodeus has taken up residence in.

To complicate the situation even further, Cade must deal with the Templar Order, which has decided that he is in league with The Adversary. Fortunately, Cade does not have to confront the Adversary solo - ultimately his Templar squad supports him. He deals with the Adversary, and the team survives, but this turn of events does not end as he expects that it would. There's much more in store for him, and the Templars.
