First, the good - Denise has a chatty, easy style and walks you through the basics of positive thinking and manifesting easily.

The bad - uses the word 'girlfriend' and 'gorgeous' too often, to the point where it becomes a bit irritating and 'try hard'.

The ugly- none of the information is new, most of the audio is filler for about 8 basic tenets of positive psychology and the whole audio could be about 2 hours long instead of 7.

There are many, many mistakes that were not edited out, which is an easy thing to fix and I cannot understand why they weren't and it ultimately negatively impacts the overall enjoyment of the audiobook and it's perceived quality. Given that she's a millionaire entrepreneur, these were things that could have and should have been fixed if only for professionalism.

There are also a bunch of mixed messages from her when relating her own experiences, which stretch her

credibility somewhat.

Overall, it's not a terrible book, it's just not a particularly good one.
