If you're a Crimson or MM Vampire fan you gotta read this series. Some say it's to sappy and sweet...yeah until the knocking around and killing starts. Until people (Vamps) are racing against time to save a Chosen (mate) or Coven member. If it weren't for the romantic interludes these action packed (sometimes) novellas would be too dark and classify as horror.
