However, her life gets even more messy when her best friend, Mandy, asks her for assistance with a case of missing girl, and Jane's three angelic companions tag along to help.

Good news though... the book gets better :) it feels as though the authors got into it by the second half, things got interesting and the flow was good. It even had me laughing at a few points. We had a story :D

It didn't have any errors that I noticed and just to be complete: this book contains sexual exploits (if that is important to you, though to be honest, you wouldn't be reading a RH if you weren't up for that, right?).
