Easy and quick to read, with some reverse harem and mafia in the mix, two things I love reading about. I did however have a few problems with this novella: - SPOILERS AHEAD-

It's no secret that I adore C.M. Stunich's writing. In fact, after I read this delicious little 20k serial I felt compelled to tell everyone about it. I'm not usually a huge fan of serials only because I find myself way too greedy for more of the story ;). However, Lure doesn't really feel like a serial, more like a novella in length. And before you ask, yes I was still greedy for more!

Lure combines two of my favorite subgenres: mafia and reverse harem (one girl, many dudes). The story starts with Adelasia getting orders from her father, Carlo (leader of the Costello family) to date three different important men, one from each family: Marcell Moran, Fortunato "Lucky" Moretti, Caj Bellincioni. The story continues with Adelasia meeting/seeing each man and I found myself glued to my kindle. Like a true mafia story, violence and alpha posturing ensued. And like a true RH, there was copious amounts of steam. Without revealing any spoilers, I will say that one scene in particular (you'll know what scene I'm talking about) was one of the best, most well-written steamy scenes I've ever read.

C.M.'s writing style is outstanding - nothing feels rushed or forced - and you get the opportunity to see into Adelasia's character without being told about her character. Does that make sense? That's one of my biggest pet peeves with writing, I want to be wooed by a character, not given a list of their attributes.

Lure was an exquisite read. It's the kind of read where you stay up WAY beyond your bedtime because you simply can't put the book down. Those are the best kind of reads, for me.
