I received a copy of She Kissed a Vampire, book 2 of The Werewolves of the West series, in exchange for my review. With Chloe being falsely accused of murder, her best friend Melanie has made her way to Palm Beach. Once there she discovers the existence of the supernatural world that she had only thought existed in fiction. Soon she realises that the supernatural guys around her are attracted to her, though there is one in particular that has caught her attention, the MIA vampire, Alcuin. With it becoming more and more clear that the Faery courts are involved, and that the whole situation goes way further than a power play by the vampires or werewolves, meaning that Chloe and Zane, along with the rest of their pack, really have their work cut out for them...

There's going to be another book!!! Massively excited to find that out once I'd finished She Kissed a Vampire. Both the books I've read in this series have a fantastic balance of love, action, paranormal and humour. I love Chloe's sarcastic streak for a start!

I liked the fact that in this book the viewpoint switched between Chloe and Melanie, but that it did it obviously (their names appear before their sections) but also I thought that there was quite a distinct difference between the two women's monologues.

There was also more of the lore involved in this book, particularly the lore related to the blood bond between vampires and the people that drank their blood, which I thought added another depth to the story, as well as being a pretty major plot point in regards to the romance between Alcuin and Melanie.

There were also conflicts between the characters that were friends.
