This is a collection of some of Norton's works, including three series. The arrangement of the books are in reverse of how they should be read, so I found myself confused at times until I read the next book which should have been read first. Known best for her science fiction space adventures, I was surprised to read a

western series set during the aftermath of the Civil War, followed by its prequel which introduced the characters and explained how the previous story came about. The last story was short and somewhat apart from the others; it seemed to have been written by a much younger Norton. I recommend reading this collection backwards to get a better impression of the stories' evolution and the author's improvement over the years.
