As you would expect, the fourth and final installment of the full novel of *Burning Desire* is full of action and excitement.

Kiril believes that Shara has betrayed him and the sense of loss is overwhelming. He cannot believe that she had helped trap him and had worked to keep him from freeing Rhi. Has she been involved with Balladyn the whole time, seducing him into believing her and waiting for the chance to capture him? How did she see his dragon magic? If Shara's betrayal wasn't enough Ulrik an exiled dragon king walks into the room Kiril is being held in and refuses to help. Ulrik has other plans and they cannot be good for the dragon kings. What is Ulrik's ultimate goal and how does he plan to accomplish it? How is Ulrik there? Didn't they bind his magic and leave him powerless?

How can Kiril believe that she would betray him even though she is a Dark Fae? He is the love of her life and she would gladly die for him. Shara knows that he will never believe her innocence now, so the only choice she has is to help free Rhi regardless of what happens to her! The thing that I really don't understand is why would an author split a book, one that's already intended to be a full novel as part of an existing series, into multiple parts releasing them just prior to the full book. yes, some readers will love getting the start a little earlier, but it just feels like a cash grab to me. especially with this part releasing the same day as the complete novel...

anyway, that has nothing to do with the actual book. after a slow start, i actually quite liked it, and may eventually get around to reading the the others in the series.

Burning Desire: Part 4 can be summed up in one word - SUSPENSEFUL. Kiril, Shara and Rhi are in as much danger as possible when Part 3 concludes. In the exciting conclusion of her latest Dark Kings book, Burning Desire, Donna Grant once again offers us a wondrous treat.

Shara and Kiril have once again grown closer and have devised a plan to save the Light Fae, Rhi who has been held in the Dark Fae Fortress. Their plans quickly go awry and Shara is accused by Balladin of aiding him in the capture of Kiril. The ruse works and Kiril has been captured. Of course nothing is ever as it should be..

An escape is planned and the "cavalry" arrives. Except even a well thought out plan can be turned on its ear. There is way more going on than the Kings are aware of. They have allies that the Dark Fae are not aware of BUT there is someone else who is working against them both. He too wants to rescue Rhi... Seems Rhi is a very valuable individual.

Action packed.. Donna once again delivers and once again ends this novel but leaves us with questions galore. Just who was the Dark King that loved Rhi? A stunning conclusion to this four part series.

Shara really comes into her own in this novella. The very foundation of what she has always believed as the truth is tested as she grows into her own woman in her own right. I loved the growth in her character and how that transpired into her relationship with Kiril. Kiril was the one who allowed her to see the truth of what she truly is and he is the one who encouraged her to be the person she wants to be, not what her family says she must be. She sacrifices it all to keep Kiril safe, risking her life and their relationship for the sake of her love for him. She was such a strong heroine and I loved her transformation throughout this novel. Kiril is my sort of hero in every sense of the word and I loved this character.

As the Dragon Kings fight the Dark Fae, Shara and Rhi disappear and Kiril is left with no choice but to return to Dreagan, to the safety of his home as they regroup and decide how to find Shara and Rhi. Kiril goes through his own transformation in realising that there is no other for him. He wants Shara with every fibre of

his being and the way he goes about showing her that is so touching and heartwarming.

Reviewing a storyline in serial format is difficult without giving away too many spoilers or sounding repetitive with each instalment. As the storyline builds, each episode reveals a little bit more information as well as the continued growth of the hero and heroine-their relationship and their love. And because each portion, in and of itself, is not a complete storyline it is difficult at times to be selective with the information passed along.

Because BURNING DESIRE continues the Dragon Kings storylines, the series should be read in order. Most of the characters from the previous storylines, and the original series and spinoff play a secondary role throughout. The Dark Kings is a spinoff from Donna's Dark Warrior series which in turn is a spin off from Donna's Dark Sword series- all set in the Highlands of Scotland. Each novella is approximately 70-75 pages in length

BURNING DESIRE part 4 see the culmination of Kiril's search for Rhi and his desire for Shara. As the Dragon Kings risk their lives looking for Rhi, information about a Dragon King aligning the with Dark Fae has everyone on edge. Has Ulrick regained some of his power or is one of their own siding with the Dark?

Donna Grant's BURNING DESIRE is a storyline of betrayal, adventure, romance and love. It is a story about destructive family dynamics, the healing nature of love, and the ongoing war between the Dragon Kings and one of their own. The Dragon Kings have something the Dark Fae want but only Constantine-the King of Kings-knows the truth about the who and what.

A little more about Rhi's storyline is revealed. We know she has a deeper connection to the Dragon Kings- a love that was shattered thousands of years before-but we are still no closer to the identification the man who broke her heart although the storyline does dance around the possibility.

I LOVE, LOVE, LOVE Dragon King Kiril. He is swoon worthy as heck - an old, very smart alpha male whose Scottish brogue makes me melt. Shara, our Dark Fae heroine, is likable also. She doesn't seem like other nasty Dark Fae. Rhi's path has changed... whether she's good or not remains to be seen. Balladyn is CREEPY! It's hard to believe he used to be a Light Fae. The truth about his relationship with Rhi is revealed... no spoilers here... The Queen of the Light Fae fortifies her position as a classy Queen! AND, of course, the other Dragon Kings shine!

I'm normally not a fan of serialized books but I just couldn't wait for the full book to be released.

This was a very good read. I highly recommend Donna's books and am addicted to them. She's a must-read author for me!

Book 3 (inclusive of all the serialized installments) could be read as a standalone but the reader's enjoyment would be exponentially enhanced if the prior books had been read previously as there are interconnected characters and a continuing story thread beneath Kiril's and Shara's story. Besides that, all the previous books are fantastic... so why skip them?
