### ***The Moor***

In the eerie wasteland of Dartmoor, Sherlock Holmes summons Mary Russell to aid the investigation of a death and some disturbing phenomena of a decidedly supernatural origin. There have been sightings of a spectral coach made of bones carrying a woman long-ago accused of murdering her husband--and of a hound with a single glowing eye. Returning to the scene of *The Hound of the Baskervilles*, Holmes and Russell investigate a mystery darker and more unforgiving than the moors themselves.
