Again, my apologies to the author. This should have been posted at the end of December, for I was given this ARC for an honest review.

I was so looking forward to the third installment of the series. The premise was promising and I always love when an author mixes work and personal lives (i.e. secretary falls in love with her boss). Add in a billionaire and you usually get a smokin' hot story filled with angst and, if you're lucky, a lot of unresolved chemistry. Unfortunately, said billionaire was just a mean asshole for the first five or six chapters (almost half the story!). Enough time to form a negative opinion on his character. It was then difficult for me to reassess my opinion once we finally got to read his point of view which seemed to come out of nowhere!

In a romance novel, I prefer to have a balanced point of view from the heroine AND the hero, but this was not the case in the present book. It's not until chapter six that we get a glimpse of how Morgan (the hero) feels about the whole situation and that he actually might have FEELINGS other than conceited love for himself and his work. He didn't come off as an overbearing Alpha, just a big jerk. So that was a turn-off for me. As with other books from the series, the relationship goes from none existent to sleeping together to him avoiding her in a couple of pages. Makes it a bit difficult to swallow.

Fortunately the story picks up when the couple are forced to prove their mettle by spending three days living in the middle of the woods with no food. "Accidents" start to crop up and you realize you've got a nasty villain hiding in plain sight. The presence of the family from Hell is both amusing and helps to bring the main plot together. They, along with the characters from the "human town", form a very good supporting cast.

Another positive note: the heroine, Valerie, is a very strong female lead. From the beginning, she is assertive, good-hearted, but won't take shit from no one! The banter exchanged between both leads is entertaining (at least), but it gets much better once Morgan opens up and actually shares his thoughts and feelings with Valerie (and the reader!)...

So, all in all, it was not a bad read, but could have been much better if Morgan's character development had been handled differently. Some exchanges are quite humorous, but it's difficult to care about the hero in the beginning. I'm posting a 3 star review, because Amazon won't let me post 3.5.
