The Mechanic's Mate by Mikea Howard is the first book in The Diesel War series. With great world building and smooth writing, the only thing that didn't work for me was more of a personal preference than a story issue.

I absolutely loved the world building in The Mechanic's Mate. Set in an entirely unique world where mechanics and technology caused wars to the shifters and fueling the Diesel War. Post war lines and treaties are holding, but are still not a guarantee. Howard creates a world so vivid even the slang is unique. I loved this aspect. The writing felt natural and smooth, making it a pleasant journey.

What didn't work for me was the relationship between Domek the Alpha and Sadie. Sadie is a natural submissive and it carried over to her transformation into wolf. This personality type is always a hard one for me to relate to. With her inability to deny her Alpha's direct order joined with her previous abuse, I just couldn't enjoy their HEA. A piece of me constantly felt uncomfortable with this dynamic, no matter how well written.

The main characters may not have worked for me, but Howard has multiple saving graces. The secondary characters added much entertainment and were just as well written as the main protagonists.

The world building is certainly not only what worked, but created an unforgettable gritty place that I will continue to visit. There is no doubt I will be reading the next installment in this series and I *hope* I know who it is about...
