I think the wolf pack thing is cool and hope we get an update on how Skylar and Dimitri are adjusting in the future.

Now all the bad stuff: the made up language drives me nuts! Just stop please! I listened to this on audio and the name for the "Guardian of us all" Carpathian/werewolf hybrid in the fake language sounds like that red haired girl in Wedding Crashers using her fake language with her imaginary friends. I laughed every time the narrator said it. The endless chants, where she goes into long, boring detail are just dumb and annoying. The early books did not have this (for the better!).

The flower fertility ritual is another very dumb and strange thing Feehan added. Skylar basically gave head to the flower in detail, it was weird and funny (not in a good way).

I barely felt the romance with Skylar and Dimitri, it was overshadowed by his captivity and wounds and all the werewolf politics going on as they deal with the mixed blood issue. There were some ok scenes but the romance really felt short changed. I know they have known each other for a long time and had a nice telepathic relationship but I wanted to see more sparks between them. I swear Skylar spent more time with Joseph and Paul than Dimitri in the book.

Christine Feehan's Dark Wolf has been nearly 12 long years in the making and its finally here.

Fans have been waiting anxiously for Sklyer to grow up and become old enough to have her own novel, while they follow the ever growing world of the Carpathians, Christine Feehan has been working diligently to create bigger plots and to bring us to stories of epic proportions.

Christine Feehan is one of the best story tellers you will ever read, because she writes like no one else can. From the very detailed world around them, to the amazing intricate language she has created, you have to read each book more than once just to take in all the impressive details she adds to each story and Dark Wolf is no exception.

We first discovered Skyler in book 8 of Dark Legend when Francesca Del Ponce, and Gabriel Daratrazanoff are finally reunited. Francesca gave up her hopes that Gabriel would return to her life, so she began the process of attempting to become more human. Eating human foods, walking in the sun, and working in a medical center where she discovers little Skyler.

Gabriel wakes from a long sleep after he chose to imprison himself and his brother to the ground, to save his soul. Both had been gravely injured after a vicious battle but instead of walking into the light he suffered because he refused to give up on his twin brother Lucian.

Gabriel finally wakes and finds his way to Francesca, who is known for 'taking in strays' and helping people, she recognizes what he is and willingly gives her life so that he can revive himself. Realizing who she is, he refuses to allow her to die so he saves her - albeit to her frustration, since him doing so ruins all the hard work she put into making herself more human again.

Refusing to leave Gabriel makes it his mission to convince Francesca that they belong together and that he is ready to be her lifemate.

After a few comical debacles with a potential suitor Gabriel finds ways to put himself in Francesca's path at the medical center she works at, where Skyler is brought in.

Recognizing the abuse Skyler was forced to endure both Francesca and Gabriel make it their responsibility to help Skyler, to remove her from her abusers household and to adopt her as one of their own.

Over the years, readers got to see a few glimpses of her now and again, they even get glimpses of Dimitri Tirunul - her future lifemate and the bond that begins to form between the two of them as the years pass. But the real deal would take nearly 12 years to come to fruition.

It was well worth the wait.

In Dark Wolf, Skyler has finally come of age, and her love for Dimitri hasn't diminished.

Fans of Christine Feehan's Dark series have been waiting a decade or so for this book. For some, there is no way anything she were to write would satisfy after a build like this. Others will be so glad to get the story, that it will be an automatic 5 star read. I'll be honest, I went into this one with my expectations at an all-time low. The past few books have been so disappointing that I was ready to quit the series. Until I found out that Skyler and Dmitri were finally on the horizon. I'm pleased to say that I enjoyed this book much more than I thought I would.

As the story begins, Dmitri is in the custody of the Lycans. He is being tortured for being a mixed blood. None of the Carpathians can find him. In fact, Skyler doesn't even think they are looking. So she teams up with her friends Josef and Paul for a rescue mission. Let me stop here and share a few thoughts right off the bat. Skyler is one powerful young woman. She is also smart, resourceful, and determined to save her man. I loved that. But what I loved even more is that Dmitri accepted that. Of course, he wanted her to stay safe, but unlike most Carpathian males, he did not forbid her assistance. He was worried for her, but he listened to her. He respected her need to help him and her ability to be smart about it.

Back to the story. Dmitri is really messed up.... like, almost dead. Yet he never succumbs. He fights to live for Skyler. And about the first third of the book is tied up in his rescue. From then on, it's about healing and dealing with the increasing tensions between the Carpathian and Lycan people. Tension, that could boil over into a war.

The plot was fairly good. But the best thing this book had going for it was the romance and its key players. Dmitri is everything you could want in a Carpathian man. He is strong and powerful without ever being an alpha-hole. He is patient and kind to his young lifemate. He loves her unconditionally and --here's something unusual-- he respects her. He never berates her; never makes her feel foolish or less than him in any way. His care and generosity don't ever make him look weak, either. He's easily one of the best heroes the series has

seen. Their love story is gentle and sweet. I believed in their feelings for one another. There's no real internal conflict, just the two of them banding together to survive the threats against their lives and their people.

The supporting cast is a who's-who of the series. From Gabriel and Francesca, to Lucian and Darius, Zacharias, Nicolas, Razavan, Ivory, Byron, Mikhail... almost everyone is here. I loved catching up with old characters and getting to know more about the "next generation" that includes Josef and Paul. The whole book felt like a homecoming in a way.

It wasn't perfect, mind you. The "spells" Skyler cast got on my nerves to no end. The chanting and rhyming have GOT TO GO. I also had a gripe about how the story dealt with the sex. Such a fine point has been placed on Skyler's sexual abuse in the past. It was the big stumbling block to her accepting Dimitri as a lifemate. Yet, when it's time for these two to get horizontal, it was way too easy. It was like she just decided she was over being raped and passed around in the sex trade for years. She decides she is over it and everything is fine. True, there is a point later in the book where she has a moment of fear, but it's really small potatoes considering her history --and considering the build-up.

And speaking of the sex, I have two other observations. One, I stand by the last review where I said I think Feehan has a ghost-writer for her sex scenes. They are unrecognizable from the earlier books. I mean, I almost fell out of my chair when Dimitri referenced his cock. And two, that flower ritual is just damn stupid.

Overall, I was satisfied with book, and pleasantly surprised. I think most Carpathian fans will be too.
