While the characters are likeable enough, particularly Abigail and Jamie, it is hard to get invested in them until midway through the book, and by then, it's almost too late. The relationship feels more rushed than believable, and it is hard to root for Seth most of the time, though there are some redemptive scenes with his

nephew Jamie. While there are some peaks in the story, it is hard to stay engaged, as the tale doesn't quite live up to its potential.

Abigail Fulton is a determined young woman, and she hopes to prove her independence as the manager of a local hotel. She doesn't realize that the position has been promised to someone else by Seth Reynolds, who is in town to renovate the hotel. He is also looking to prove himself, and he does not believe that Abigail can help his cause. He sees her as nothing but a distraction, and she views him as too stiff and solemn. Is it possible for these two to work together and discover that first impressions can be misleading?
