There are rules the Kings have to follow in regards to their loves, but they know when they are born and can connect on a psychic level with them before they meet.

The background of the Kings is interesting in concept, but was sometimes written in a boring manner. The dialogue is long winded and sappy at times. The beginning of the story and up until the end needs more back story and character development. It seems the author Julia Mills has adopted some of Christine Feehan's Dark series ideas. Okay this is a vampire read... but not. Viktor is from ancient Greece three thousand years ago. Yea, he's old. On his deathbed, which was a complete injustice, he prayed to the Greek Gods to keep his friends and family safe. Zeus does one better. He grants him immortality, and Viktor becomes a King of the Blood. Zeus also allows Viktor to choose some of his loyal followers in the the mortal life to follow him into immortality and also become a King of the Blood. As a King of the Blood they are required to drink blood once a month to sustain their life, and they also dedicate their lives to eradicate evil from our world. Each King has a mate (they call it something else in their native tongue) that will bring them light and make them feel whole. If

their mate hasn't been turned and officially mated to the King before their 3,000th year, the King will die (again) and the woman is free to live out her life. It's her choice. Viktor has waiting 3,000 years for his mate and she is finally here...

Every King knows when their mate is born, but they cannot contact or seek out the woman unless they are in mortal danger. They have to wait for their mate to come to them. Viktor had to wait until his mate was about 30 years old to meet her. Once he does he has no intentions of ever letting her go.

This is a unique spin on the vampire story. I love that it incorporates Greek mythology and that is how the Kings are "made". Throughout the entire story Viktor is completely devoted to Kat and vice versa. However, nothing is said about their pasts. Was Viktor celibate the *entire 3,000 years*?! We know she isn't a virgin. Viktor has been a passive participant in her mind for 30 years. How did he cope when she was with someone else?! I don't know. It doesn't matter that much to me; I just found it a bit of an oversight by the author. I always want to know something about the MCs past relationships and how that has affected them now in the present.

Oh my! Oh my! Oh my! I love it! I've been a diehard Julia Mills fan for years. After having read and enjoyed every single book Mills has ever published, I can declare, Viktor: Heart of Her King, the first release in her stunning new Kings of the Blood Series, is extraordinary! All you have to do is whisper the words, handsome alpha males, courageous warriors of good, fated mates and Julia Mills, in the same breath, and I'm all over it! But before I continue, please allow me to explain how I rate a book. First, I'd like to say I'm not a professional reviewer, but I do know what I like, what I don't, and most importantly, what I love. It's really very simple but remember, this is only my opinion and everyone is entitled to their own. If it's just plain 'gawd awful', it gets a one. If it's a 'hot mess' but shows promise, I rate it a two. If I like it but it needs a little editing love, then I give it a three. If I like it a lot and there are no major problems with the book, but would not reread it, it earns a four. And finally, if I truly love the book and hear the angels sing every time I pick it up, then it has earned a five star rating from me. And I think you know what I'm talking about - the kind of book you just can't seem to put down or stop reading. I think we've all read some of those, but I have to admit, I'm pretty lenient when it comes to editing errors. As long as they are relatively minor, few and far between, and don't distract me from the actual story, then I don't criticize or penalize the author. Hey, everyone makes mistakes. We're all human, right? I sure hope so!

Viktor: Heart of Her King is exceptionally well crafted with one of the most unique storylines I've read in quite a while. The premise is stunningly original and remarkably well developed. The narrative is extremely

well written in the third person with alternating points of view from the two protagonists. The dialogue is well executed and flows beautifully. There are a few editing errors but none that interrupted the flow of the story. And the final element, the *pièce de résistance*, is the cast of magnificent characters Mills has given us. They are fascinating, captivating, intriguing, engaging and extraordinarily well developed. They explode from the pages and capture your heart. After reading the prologue, I was completely smitten and irrevocably drawn into the story. By the end of the first chapter, I knew that this series would be one I would remember and reread for many years to come!

Three thousand years ago, a courageous and loyal warrior of Greece, Supreme Commander Viktoras, was betrayed by a cowardly traitor and accused of heinous crimes he did not commit. He was judged by the Council of Ancestors and sentenced to die; his years of loyal service and many victories rewarded with only the foulest punishment of his kind. During his trial, he prayed fervently to Athena, the Goddess of War for vindication and justice but received only silence in response to his pleas. He had been deserted and left to suffer his fate alone. No matter his belief in the doom he faced, on the eve of his death, he prayed directly to Zeus, the Father of the Gods, for a miracle to be bestowed upon him. The King of the Gods responded to his plea and granted him life after death. On the thirty-first day after the date of his death, he would arise from his grave. He would draw breath, his heart would once again beat and he would become immortal. Viktoras would be known as 'The Unum', The One, the first King of the Blood. He was sworn to serve a higher purpose and smite the enemies that mortal men could not defeat. Viktoras was also granted the power to call into service those loyal to him and his cause, and make them his brethren and fellow Kings of the Blood. Together, they would form a fraternity unlike any other with the sole purpose of protecting the innocent and those who could not protect themselves. But as in life and the laws of nature, there is always a price and for Viktoras it would be twofold. First, in order to remain immortal, he would need to consume blood, life's essence, once every new moon. It must be given willingly and accepted gratefully and only the smallest amount taken in order to replenish his power and the donor must be left unblemished and unharmed. Second, he would be granted by the gods a *custos animae*, the keeper of his heart, the one woman who can save his soul and breathe life into his dead heart. He will know when she is born into the universe and must wait for her to come to him. Once they meet and upon her recognition of him as her mate, she will become his only source of nourishment. Without her acceptance and life essence, he will die. But the mating must be completed before nightfall on the anniversary of his three thousandth year or he will cease to exist. And so, with the promise of life after death from the King of the Gods, Viktoras, the Supreme Commander, surrendered to his fate, gave over his spirit to the gods and Viktor Katsaros was born. Now, fast forward three millennia to six months prior to the anniversary of his three thousandth year and read the story of how charismatic Viktor Katsaros finally meets beautiful, savvy Katarina Romalesky, the keeper of his heart. Although Kat may be Viktor's greatest gift, she is also his greatest weakness of which his greatest enemy is also aware. Unfortunately, even the passing of three thousand years is not enough time to seek revenge and eliminate the heinous enemies who will once again try to manipulate fate in order to bring about the death of the loyal, benevolent warrior Viktoras.
