Carlynn Whitt's colorful action scenes add much to this predictable adventure, but too many of them focus on the crowd and not enough on the players and the game itself. If you're looking for a picture book that describes a baseball game, then this is for you. But if you're looking for a good baseball story, keep looking. "Ballpark" is not a home run.
