This is where Muddy Rivers and his gang takes us in search for his brother, who has vanished. Of course, the characters need a mentor to guide them. An old blues player called Silver Eye steps up to the plate. After being confronted by this group of teenage misfits, Silver Eye offers them peculiar yet exceptional instruments to carry as protection. He teaches the kids as much as they will allow and shows them the way to this other realm. Then he warns them to train with him before beginning their quest for Muddy's brother. Restless, they sneak in ahead of their teacher and face disastrous consequences.

David Simms brings the story alive with his unlikely heroes and the fantastic obstacles they must overcome. Not only is it action packed, it joggles the brain with lyrical teasers. He consistently entertains the reader
