She literally flits through the town making matches left and right while ignoring Kin. She is intercepted by a supernatural being (Delta) that wants to talk to her, but her recently returned mother interferes time after time to keep the being away from Lexi.

What does Delta want? Turns out she wants Lexi to embrace her father's gifts and find his missing bow and arrow. Don't worry, he isn't a hunter. Lexi's dad is the God of Love, Cupid.

Much confusion between what Delta wants and what her mother (Slyvana) wants. Lexi chooses to spend time with her mom, hoping to catch up on many of those mother-daughter times she has missed in the last 24 years. However hopes and wishes don't always come true even for a witch who has 4 farie godmothers watching over her-no hovering in her life.

This fast paced and exciting story has twists and surprises throughout the book. As the second book in the series (and yes! You HAVE to read them in order. If you haven't read A MATCH MADE IN SPELL, stop and read it right away. You won't regret it!) less time is spent in the business of match making, and more time training Lexie in witchcraft. However it is a good balance between the two as it allows Lexi to grow and become a better witch and person. I couldn't read this fast enough-it was so good.
