My advice to beginners would be not to use this book as a learning tool. Learn ALL the basics first and get a very good understanding of what the stitches look like, what your gauge should be if it is necessary, AND know how to read a pattern. Once you have got everything down pat and are comfortable with crocheting THEN this book may be a good reference guide for you. This book may cause you unnecessary frustration or cause you to give up easily if you are just learning/beginning to crochet. There are better sources out there to help you on your journey of becoming a GREAT YARNIE!!!!
