Wanted to like this one since I've enjoyed others by the author, but lots of things were revealed quickly which made it feel rush. I really liked the idea of this book, but it just didn't work out for me. I tried liking Anna, but she just seemed a bit off and naive.

-Content up to what I read:

Spiritual Content- 2 Peter 1:3-4 at the beginning; A few Scriptures are quoted, read, & remembered; Prayers; Talks about God, believing, & sin; 'H's are capital when referring to God;

Anna has a faith, but Lucas believes you can only depend on yourself and is a bit bitter;

Mentions of God & believing; Mentions of prayers & praying; Mentions of Bibles & Bible reading;

Mentions of churches & church going; Mentions of faiths; A few mentions of those & events in the Bible; A

few mentions of getting religion; A couple mentions of praising God; A couple mentions of a preacher; A

*Note: Mentions of an evil person; A couple mentions of luck.

Negative Content- Minor cussing including: 1 'idiot', 1 'stupid'; Some Sarcasm & Eye rolling;

Being threatened & pain (up to semi-detailed); A car accident, pain, injuries, & blood/bleeding (semi-detailed);

Many mentions of a killer, seeing a murder, blood/bleeding, a sting operation, & being shot (barely-above-not-detailed); Mentions of almost being killed, murders, & deaths; Mentions of crimes, criminals, crime

families, & jails; Mentions of being ran off the road & injuries (barely-above-not-detailed); Mentions of

gunfire, being shot, & pain (up to semi-detailed); Mentions of a fire & death; Mentions of nightmares; A few

mentions of gun running & transporting illegal aliens; A couple mentions of smoking & pipes; A couple

mentions of piercings;

*Note: A few mentions of & going to Starbucks; A few mentions of car brands.

Lucas is an American doctor who left his North Carolina home after his brother's violent death, that he blames himself for. Lucas and Anna have worked together for three years becoming friends, both keeping their attraction to the other at bay. When Lucas asks Anna to accompany nine year old Paulo to America for a heart transplant, Anna agrees reluctantly. The hospital donating their services is in the same North Carolina city where Anna had been shot and returning there, Anna worries she'll be in danger. Lucas doesn't know about Anna's past with the FBI, but then he hasn't confided his past either and the reason he left his home. When their lives are put a risk almost as soon as they arrive, Anna is sure someone in the FBI leaked that she was back. After several attempts on her life, Anna is determined to find the evidence to nail the mob boss behind it all.
