This book is the follow-up to Inevitable Detour. What sets this book apart from book one is the dual POV. Getting Farren Shaw's side gave an added edge to the tone of the story. After book one's cliffhanger, I had to finish this story. Despite the rating, this was not a terrible book. It was an okay read. The premise of this story was intriguing, but some things just didn't work for me:

-intimacy scenes are lukewarm at best and very quick

-Essa declares that Shaw is an "alpha male," but there's little evidence of this, other than her inner proclamation of that belief

-this book lacks the suspense and intensity expected, especially with the themes explored (kidnapping, human trafficking, assassination)

-Essa grows a backbone shortly after meeting the hero, so much that she changes career plans that were

cemented in stone by her parents, pursues a dual major, and moves in with the hero

-the hero is so concerned for the heroine's safety that he leaves the country without securing personal security for her? Up to that point, he was hell bent on keeping her at arm's length.

-heroine is convinced that she's capable of being a sniper after 5 minutes of private training, but when the opportunity for her to demonstrate the action presents, she has an epiphany and backs down?

I did like the comic relief provided by Justin and Doctor Hottie. Also, I liked that Haven ultimately had her own HEA.
