To compound her problems, the hotel is expecting a Hotel Critic and Maisie suspects that the critic is the chronic complainer in the suite next door, Mrs. Richardson. In an effort to calm Mr. Dayton, Maisie asks Mike, one of her Security team, to stand guard outside his room to ensure that nobody enters.

Fortunately, Mr. Dayton is scheduled to check out the next day and the Security Guard, Mike, confirms that his is packing to leave.
