Rob, is the new cop in town who is dealing with multiple issues at home and work. He's no stranger to his new colleagues, they know of him and his recently deceased father, a highly respected police officer. This eases his transition into the new station but also adds a level of expectation.

His wife Amy has no idea how to deal with the man she loves and the distance slowly emerging in their marriage. It was interesting to read about a couple fighting for each other in a practical way. There was minimal drama but a lot of soul-searching prompted by wise onlookers who were able to guide them through with caring and sensitive dialogue. While their situation was confronting and challenging it was written with sincerity. The suspense and personal struggles drew me into the story. The evidence or knowledge of what was happening always felt close and confirmed they were on the right track. Rob was astutely aware the evidence he has to work on doesn't add up but he refuses to give up despite the mounting dead ends he and his partner are discovering.

This was my first Linda Winfree book and it won't be my last! I was rewarded for taking a chance on it with it being a genuine standalone story. In the beginning, I was worried I would be disadvantaged by starting with the 10th book in the series, but it didn't affect my enjoyment of the book at all. Now to find the time to backtrack and check out the other books I've skipped! It's something I'll keep in mind with the suspense and nature of the stories I usually read being a lot heavier than this, but I was pleasantly surprised how much I enjoyed reading *Gone From Me*!

I loved that Troy Lee was one of the characters that got a lot of page time being Rob Bennett's partner. Troy Lee was always the butt of the jokes in the previous books and its good to see him shown in a great supporting role again.

What the author, to me, is best at is showing us the uglier side of relationships whether that be from two people just starting out or a couple that has been married for 3 years. She's also not afraid to have the man be the one with the biggest issues in the relationship. Rob was a man who had it all – a father who was also his best friend, a woman he was madly in love with and a good job with the Georgia Bureau of Investigation. After losing his father suddenly, getting laid off from the GBI and finding out he was infertile he spirals into a deep depression that threatens his marriage. He has just started with the Chandler County Sheriff's dept and is partnered with Troy Lee and struggling to keep dark thoughts from his head. With the support of his partner and his wife he finally seeks the helps he needs.

As with all books in this series there is also crime/murder/mystery to solve. I should have seen what the outcome was going to be but like the investigators I didnt see what the truth was until the end. I will say I absolutely loved how the author handled the reveling and the aftermath, heartbreaking as it was.

This series has been one that has stayed with me over 9 years. I've not forgotten any of the stories or the characters even with the latest years long break in between. That is how good, I think, this series is.
