Although it helps if you have read Brad Taylor's earlier works, in order to have the full scope of the main characters, "Gut Instinct" is a pleasurable and entertaining short story. The tale opens with Pike Logan visiting Taskforce partner Jennifer Cahill just as her not-so-polite, jerk of an ex has shown up unexpectedly for an unwanted visit. Once she is away with him, Jennifer is contacted for an assignment.

While she is an experienced operative this task is due to her sex. Pike tags along, though injured from his most recent job, and not of much use. The team leader of the assignment really doesn't want her there and dismisses her "gut instinct" (or possibly woman's intuition) so she and Pike take matters in their own hands in an attempt to stop a terrorist action. For a short story Taylor does a credible job of keeping the reader turning pages with some good action.

This is a pleasant pick-me-up for the waiting-for-the-next-novel reader, and the teaser for "The Widow's Strike" makes the waiting a bit harder. A 3.5 rounded up to 4 star.
