Not knowing each other hardly at all before marriage, the two must now come to know each other. They both think they have figured the other one out, but what they don't know is that they are both living double lives. Quinn decides to help the poor female population who either are or destined to be prostitutes because they have no other choice as: "A Sympathetic Lady." Marcus temporarily takes up the mantel from Luke (from Rogue's Honor and the first of the Saint of Seven Dials books) while he is on his honeymoon to be The Saint of Seven Dials in order to draw suspicion away from his friend.
