This is my first time reading from this author and she definitely didn't disappoint me!!! This story was fun, sexy, mysterious, and unique that I could NOT stop! The author kept the reader guessing with what was actually happening within the storyline and nothing seemed too obvious that I had it all figured out beforehand. The storyline flowed effortlessly and kept the reader captivated with the right amount of intrigue and strong relationships among the characters. Speaking of characters, they were all well developed and none seemed to be incomplete from a reader's point of view. We had a small yet powerful amount of background on each of the Hounds that helped the reader understand the characters and how they behaved. Now Sara... she is the typical hardheaded and strong female lead that I ABSOLUTELY love to read about.

Great job to the author and I will definitely be finishing this series and reading some other works from her!

The first few pages almost threw me off; I wasn't sure if I was going to like Everly, or if she was going to just be a bit of a whiner. I'm glad that I kept reading, though, because Michaels has developed a story-line and a world that is actually quite unique.

Everly is very much stuck in the monotony of death where her only real adventure comes from fighting off the evil spirits that seem determined to overtake her. Not much fun, right? Even though she can still travel the world, watch Netflix (as long as someone doesn't turn the TV off), and occasionally mess with the living by exploding their drinks, being dead is a pretty lackluster existence.

When she meets Jack, it almost seems like Michaels is copping out- Everly and this mysterious "Voodoo Man" fall into an immediate lust, and it seems like Jack can't get enough of her. I almost gave up again even though I swear I'm not usually such a big quitter. Sometimes, I just get sick of the "insta-love."

HOWEVER (and yes, it deserves caps lock), even though Everly doesn't know it, she and Jack have a past. He's not just instantly falling for and risking his life for a strange ghost; Everly is someone very special to him and his fellow hounds, someone that they lost and desperately need to get back.

Now that Everly has returned to Jack and the Hounds, the questions keep piling up: Who killed her? Why? When and how will she finally become herself once again?

I love that Michaels created a new background for a creature that I've come across in many incarnations: Hell Hounds. Her hounds are not merely supernatural canines; they are souls that have been pledged to Lucifer in the pursuit of the malanum (evil spirits) that are loose in the human world. Not only is this a newer twist on an old creature, but Michaels has created individual backstories for each of the hounds in Everly's harem, and they're all quite interesting.

They're heroes, in a way, because they fight evil, but each of the men (and Everly as well) are not pristine, shiny protectors. There's a lot of pain and darkness in the lives they've lived and in the afterlives since they've all become pack.

There's not too much action in this first book- it's very much character-driven, so a lot of the "action" is all about the relationships between Everly and the hounds, her progression to regain her memories and sense of

self, and how she can become strong again and make her pack back into the whole, formidable force that earned them the title of Lucifer's favorites.

In terms of the steam, it's definitely not a slow burn. Everly's physical relationship moves forward differently with each of the men, but there are more than enough scenes to keep thirsty readers fanning themselves.

Overall, I was very pleasantly surprised by this book, and I immediately borrowed book 2, so I could find out what happens next.

He can see her, hear her and touch her - everywhere. Soon, Everly learns that not everything is as it seems, even herself. Taking his hand, she ventures into her own wonderland and discovers a past that holds a different name, lovers that touch her soul and a mission that, quite literally, killed her.

Overall, this is an epic ride that edges the border between sublime and taboo. Everly, real name Sara, is everything a lost Heroine should be, while her men each have strong personalities of their own (a facet of RH that far too many Authors neglect). The tried and true method of introduction - no one can see her, she's a ghost, blah blah blah, turned me off at first - as it follows a growing pattern in the RH genre.
