I mean it in the sense that it's so rich, so filled with passion and poise that it draws you so fully into the reading experience that for a time you forget you're actually reading a book- you feel as if you are a part of the story, that you are experiencing the events along with the characters. Now, right off I have to say, out of the three main characters introduced to us in The Fray Theory: Resonance, Dylan wasn't at the top of my favourite's list. And that's not because I didn't like him, it was because I connected so much more with Neve and Romer at the time.
