But know Ms. Bracco gives Alex and Quinn their own series in Fallacy (Apprehension #1). Fallacy can be read as a stand-alone but I definitely recommend read the Inhibitions books to meet Alex's best friend Tanner and his dirty mouth. Alex and Quinn were just supposed to be a one-night only thing-no strings, no dating, no relationship. That's what Quinn did with all her men. Sleep with the once and then goodbye. But after that one time, Quinn finds herself hanging out with Alex and really becoming friends with him.
