Having used up a pile of tissues on Her Ride - which I highly recommend you read before this. In fact, I would suggest you go and do it before finishing this review, as it may mention things you discover in book 1.

This book is narrated by Melia, a woman who feels an obligation to help her mother's friend, (Shannon) Ryan, and Patrick (aka Wrench), Ryan's brother. They start out a million miles apart, but their connection develops through Ryan and Ellis (aka Dirty). It is fun being the reader, as we benefit from knowing what each one thinks. I enjoyed the biker club context, and the issues that Wrench faces, as he tries to clean up his act for his family. There were some very funny scenes, and some very moving ones.

This is a worthy second story from Ms Orman, and I am delighted that there is another book to come and I will definitely be reading it as soon as I can.

Her Journey takes off from where we left off in "Her Ride." Therefore I recommend that you read "Her Ride" first if you want to get to know and understand the characters of the Tormented Souls Motorcycle Club. The main difference in this second book is the featured couple; a shift away from Ryan & Ellis aka "Dirty" to Patrick aka "Wrench" & Melia. That been said, Ryan and Ellis's story continues as it is closely interwoven with that of Patrick and Melia's.

Patrick and Melia's worlds literally collided when they first meet. Neither knows who the other is, but

manage to create a lasting first impression of each other for all the wrong reasons. When their stars are once again aligned; sparks start to fly.

Patrick is very much a stereotypical alpha man-whore. He's president of the MC, and used to women scratching his itch on demand. He's rough and demanding, showing little respect for the whores that throw themselves at him. Melia is a freelance photographer but more importantly the surrogate to Patrick's unborn niece or nephew. She's also a woman that is willing to stand up for herself; outspoken and unwavering. Melia doesn't like to be treated like a doormat and likewise, Patrick is taken aback by the fact another woman besides his sister Ryan, is willing to verbally stand up to him.

I spent most of the story trying to figure out why Patrick acted and behaved the way he did with women. Most of the time he was such an a*sehole, with tiny glimpses of someone that is capable of deeper, meaningful feelings. It was such a relief to finally try and understand the reasons behind his behavior with women.

Melia is equally frustrating. We are lead to believe that she has had problems with men and relationships in her past. Her own father was abusive. So, it was difficult to find a plausible reason why a woman would be attracted to such an ass as Patrick. I guess the "Off the chart" sex was just too good to resist. ;-)

This was a quick, likeable read with alternating POV's of Patrick and Melia. I found a few spelling errors, but these didn't spoil the overall enjoyment of this book.

His real name is Ellis, and he is not what you would expect from a member of a motorcycle club. He is kind and so sweet, just like the love of his life, Ryan. They helped her mother deal with the disease while she and Ryan had their treatments together. How could you not form a bond with someone when you both have poison dripping into your veins that can save your life but at the same time makes you feel like you are dying? As a result of the treatments and surgery, Ryan cannot carry a child. So Melia offers to carry a baby for Ryan and Dirty if In-Vitro works. After two rounds Melia is pregnant with Dirty and Ryan's babies, ah yeah, twins. Melia decides to leave DC, to move across country so Ryan can help Melia with her pregnancy. Melia is a photographer and she can take pictures anywhere, and can probably pick up clients for weddings in any part of the world. Melia is soon introduced to the other members of the MC, including Ryan's brother Patrick, aka Wrench. Her Journey is the story of Melia and Patrick (AKA Wrench). Wrench is Ryan's story Brother and the MC President of the Tormented Souls MC who we met in Her Ride. He's sexy, tattooed, can wear a suit and look just as good in that as he can in his jeans and cut, is an a**hole and doesn't have to work hard for women as they naturally flock to him.

Melia first meets Ryan and Dirty when Ryan is in hospital receiving chemo treatments and she is Melia's mother's roommate. When her mother passes away, Melia decides to do the selfless act of becoming a surrogate for Ryan and Dirty. When she starts to have pregnancy complications and ordered on bed rest for 1 month, Ryan and Dirty move her into the MC Compound so they can keep an eye on her.

Her and Wrench do not hit it off and both rile each other up from the first time they meet. They stay out of each other's way as every time they are near they start arguing and you can feel the underlying sexual attraction build with each argument.

When Melia's life is put in danger as a direct result of being involved with the MC, Wrench seeks revenge and Melia takes off to clear her head only returning a month later. Can the two reconcile and find the happiness they both deserve?

Patrick "Wrench" Ryan is a man with the weight of the world on his shoulders. He's had to sit back and watch his sister battle the BIG "C" and the helplessness that came with it. He's also trying to move his club to a more mainstream source of funds, with varying success. He knows that anything illegal will taint the future of his sister's children and he doesn't want that for them. He strives for control, because if it can control the world, he can keep his family safe.

Melia, suffering the loss of her mother, her last living relative, has offered to carry Ryan and Ellis' (Dirty's) child. Ryan and Malia's mom had become friends while taking chemo treatments together and Ryan had

been there after her mother's death. Wanting to do something for the people who had been her rock, she offered to become their surrogate.

Melia's a spunky, fiercely independent woman, who owns a photography business. While at the hospital for her mother's cancer treatments she meets and befriends another woman, Ryan.

Ryan and Melia become even closer after her mother's passing. Ryan's in need of help and turns to Melia. Without a second thought Melia agrees but part of this help means that she will need to stay with Ryan for a couple of weeks at Ryan's brother Wrench's house.

Patrick aka Wrench is the president of the Tormented Souls Motorcycle Club. He's an alpha who does things his way. He has no filter and his temper is well known. He's also a business man who plans to make a name for himself other than just a president for a MC. The last thing he is looking for is a relationship, he prefers uncomplicated sex only.

Before Ryan can move Melia into the house she needs to make it clear to her brother as to why. It doesn't sit well with Wrench but for the sake of Ryan he'll do anything for this sister. He makes it his mission to get to know Melia but for the wrong reasons. He thinks he knows the type of woman he's dealing with but he's completely wrong. Melia has been living a pretty solitary life for years. She and her mother barely escaped from an abusive father when she was younger, and then it sounds like her mother, whether she realized it or not, taught Melia not to really reach out to people or trust them. Melia's mom changed, however, when she got cancer and spent most of her time in a hospital receiving treatment. While there, she met Shannon Ryan, or just Ryan, who was also undergoing treatment for cancer. Melia's mom really connected with Ryan, and, after she passed away, Melia also felt very connected to Ryan. In fact, she decided to step outside of her solitary existence and do something for Ryan and Ellis, her man, in order to feel alive again. She agreed to have a baby for them, as Ryan can no longer have a baby, herself.

Melia is a photographer, so she is able to move to be closer to Ryan and Ellis, but that means that she also has to come into contact with their lifestyle – the biker lifestyle. And that lifestyle is all wrapped up in Ryan's brother, Patrick, or "Wrench", which is his biker name. The two of them do not get off to a good start, as Patrick is really kind of a jerk, normally, and Melia and her pregnant hormones do not take well to that. Patrick is in a downward spiral of apathy, as he is struggling to care about the usual things. Melia brings life back into his life. All of this sounds really cliché, but the two of them have chemistry whether they are talking or flirting with one another. They very quickly realize this, themselves, when Patrick is shot and Melia takes care of him. He thanks her in the only way that he really knows how – physically.

The two of them continue to have moments together, but they then run away from the other and have constant misunderstandings. Meanwhile, Patrick has been experiencing some trouble from a rival MC, and he does not think to add Melia, who is pregnant with Ryan and Ellis's babies, to his "protected list". Someone else has been watching her, too, and realizes that she is important to the MC. Can Patrick figure out his feelings fast enough to protect her?

I liked this story better than the first book in the series. I feel like the author's writing was better, which is a good thing, as the series is coming together in a tighter manner. Melia sometimes did not seem consistent to me, and I guess, based on her description, I had her pegged as somewhat shy and conservative. She would occasionally say some things that did not seem consistent with that, however, so I felt confused about who her character was. I loved Patrick, though, and I think that they ended up being a good couple together.

Ryan brings Melia to the club when she's put on bed rest and straight into the path of Patrick aka Wrench, Ryan's brother. He's strong, protective tough, tattooed and dominant. It wasn't an easy choice to make and would require some sacrifices on her part, but the end result would be worth it. What she couldn't have anticipated was the man that decision would bring in to her life; Ryan's Brother, Wrench. He is everything she should avoid and the last thing she needs, he makes her blood boil yet she has never been so attracted to anyone before, if they're not biting each others heads off they're trying to rip each others clothes off-she has never been more confused or frustrated. Try as she might, she just can't get him out of her head.

He doesn't like it, tries to fight it, but what Ryan wants Ryan gets. From the minute he meets Melia they bash heads, her mouth and attitude sets his temper off at the drop of a hat but he can't deny how much she turns him on...and that just pisses him off even more. He wants her like no other, but it is clear she is not a casual hook-up kinda girl and he can offer her nothing more than that; he has been burned in the past and refuses to give anyone else that kind of power over him ever again. When trouble with a rival MC escalates, Wrench will have to take matters into his own hands to protect those most important to him and it makes him realize that some matter more than he cares to admit.

There was so much I loved about this book, it had a lot of the things I look forward to in an MC romance; no

shortage of drama, plenty of angst, action and passion with lots of dirty, hott sex plus a ton of fantastic characters. Wrench took awhile for me to warm up to, the dude was just a complete ass most of the time, but I got there.
