Rating: This was quintessential Lisa Marie Rice with a total uber-alpha hero, an absolutely perfect woman who is so beautiful, smart, and caring that she's practically a Disney character, and a crazysauce suspense element involving biochemical warfare, as you do. The problem is that I didn't get anything new from this LMR outing. Nick and Kay followed the same standard LMR pattern - the hero pants and the heroine heaves

as they circle each other in a haze of respectful sexual chemistry, then they have off-the-charts sex, followed by inexplicable danger, and then everyone is saved by the All-Alpha ASI squad.
