Shokugeki no Soma - Food Wars! Volume 4: Resemblances picks up where the last volume left off - Megumi is dangling on the edge of expulsion and now she and Soma must find a way to impress the arrogant alumni in an unofficial shokugeki. Let's break it down.

Megumi and Soma vs Shinomiya gets Megumi a surprising amount of character growth this volume and it was a good boost for her character! We get even more insight to her extremely intense anxiety and we get to see her work at overcoming as she slowly begins to build a little confidence. We also see a side of Soma we haven't see yet - one that has suffered a defeat. Because even with the results being a tie, that was merely a twist of fate. Soma has to learn that failure sometimes comes along, too. As for Shinomiya, they gave us a backstory for him that I wasn't expecting, so no doubt we'll see him again. I did quite enjoy the story as it gives us a reason for why he was so defensive over Megumi changing his recipe. I just love Shinomiya, okay? ♥?

Soma aside from learning how to handle defeat, it seems Soma is in quite a bind at the end of this volume. Something has happened during this Buffett breakfast and it's causing Soma not to be serving enough food to the customers. We don't yet know what he's chosen to make, but whatever it is isn't drawing as much attention as Erina's beautifully done Eggs Benedict, Takumi's Insalata Frittata, or Megumi's Breakfast Stew. I have faith he'll figure out a way to pass, but things aren't going well for her right now.

Mystery Girl and Scary Guy who are you? I don't like the girl. She reminds me of Erina. Now her friend seems interesting. He screams tough guy even if those bags under his eye make him look a bit wimpy.

Erina... I still hate you. Surprise surprise.
