It starts off with a simple girl, Kylie, dealing with her parents divorce, and moving to Rome with her mother. Kylie's Mother doesnt seem to be her normal self, Kylie soon realises this when she pulls up outside her new home and her mother doesnt seem to be 'focased' if you like. Soon a guy who visits Kylie in her dreams named Johnathon comes to see her mum as he thinks she is ill.

Kylie and Johnathon soon begin talking and the decision is made that Johnathon will drive Kylie to school the next morning because of the situation of Kylies mothers car.

The next day Johnathon and Kylie spend the day in school together, Kylie soon realises that something is different about Johnathon apart from visiting her in her dreams.

That evening Kylie goes home to find her mother in bed, and finds out that her mother has been in bed all day. She goes downstairs after talking to her mum and distracts herself with some homework. A few hours later Johnathon turns up with food as they dont have anything to eat in the house. Kylie goes upstairs to get her mother when she finds her breathing weakly and looking bad. Johnathon drives them to the hospital and stays there with Kylie for a few days, discovering that Kylie's mother took and overdose on her medication for depression.

After discovering how Kylie felt about Johnathon she and him spend a day out in Rome and visits his dead mothers garden. He tells Kylie that he loves her and when he discovers that his feeling are returned he tells her EVERYTHING...including thats his a vampire.

He tells her that they are soul mates and soon everything seems to add up. But another truth that is told is hard to cope with. Kylie's mother died because of the overdose and to help Johnathon turned her into a vampire.

Kylie copes well with this new information, but she has to move up the road and stay with Johnathon and his family because her mother cant control herself around humans just yet. Life goes on and Kylie soon starts to resieve notes from a stranger, however she keeps them to herself not wanting to worry anyone.

One evening while Johnathon and his family are out, the person responsible for the notes is in Kylies bedroom and Kylies worst fear is confirmed.....Another vampire. Who apparently really doesnt like Kylie.

The vampire Selena scared Kylie and she realises not all vampires are kind like Johnathon and his crew. Kylie doesnt want to be turned into a vampire incase she becomes like Selena. When she tells Johnathon this he leaves Kylie with his family and disappears for months.

Kylie gets close to a friend at school named Isaac and when he takes her to watch his band preform in a local hang-out, he kisses her. Kylie pulls away and goes home. When they go back to school, Isaac apoligizes for his behaviour and is soon forgiven. Kylie and Isaac go to the dance together as friends, still no sign on Johnathon.

At the dance, everything seems to be ok, but Kylie is kidnapped by Selena and soon finds herself in a locked, dark room with ... her father? - Selena had got him too. Selena soon kills Kylies father and Johnathon saves her, unfortunately a bit to late for her dad.

Everything continues, and Kylie gets over her fathers death, goes to his funeral with her brothers and soon enough she is living a normal life with Johnathon and his family whilst her mother is gradually improving on her control skills.

That is until Kylie recives anothe note from the suspected dead Selena....
