It has to be said, there IS such a thing as too much intrigue. Overall, I enjoyed reading this debut novel, but there was a bit too much missing to make it hit my 'best' list.

The characters, even supporting characters, were eventually fleshed out enough to be engaging. With so many unknowns about everyone's backgrounds, though, it took quite awhile to get there.

There was also a bizarre amount of world building/setting. Bizarre in that there are points where directions are given, down to the names of streets, but the more broad, general idea of who these people are in the world (Duncan does attend a 'red carpet' type event at one point, but very generically) is left out.

I did enjoy the knowledge that comes with the multiple 3rd person points of view. It would have been nice to get a little more from Duncan, but otherwise it was clear and helpful.

While I did feel some things were a bit rushed, I really appreciated the lack of extra drama and angst around the culmination of the main relationship. With so much else going on it would have been over-the-top to add that.

Finally, that epilogue.... Ugh!!! It's like the end of the Harry Potter novels in reverse (I always hated the quick wrap up of the rest of their lives.) In this case, I was almost, sorta content and then ... Bah! I hate waiting for the next in a series. Lol.
