And the story was good, although I feel like this book was geared more towards a younger crowd than me. The description on Goodreads makes it sound "young adult" but I think it's more for younger teens. I feel like it lacked some character development, and it's written from the perspective of an 18(?) -year-old boy but I had trouble believing that. I think the feel of the narration would have fit better if the main character had been his younger sister (maybe that's just me though).
