REVIEW: VEGAS KNIGHTS is an erotic contemporary romance storyline that focuses on Kelly Saunders- a big, beautiful curvaceous woman – and Rick Knight- a motorcycle riding billionaire who wants something more than a size two woman with plastic boobs. There is a short prequel novella available that explains how Rick and Kelly met but I have been told you can read Vegas Knights without the prequel.

The premise of the story finds our heroine Kelly, saying goodbye to corporate America and heading off to Vegas on the back of a virtual stranger's motorcycle. While she and Rick had a quick torrid affair, nothing would compare to the nights they would spend together on the road heading to Vegas. But Kelly's life will begin to spiral out of control when she is left alone and hungers for friendship and an outlet for her artistic ability.

VEGAS KNIGHTS is an interesting and erotic tale about the sexual adventures of two people who belong together but circumstances threaten to tear them apart. But it is Rick's failure to tell the complete truth that will place Kelly in a difficult position when a surprising opportunity presents itself that could further her artistic career. The outline and threat were predictable as well as frustrating when the reader knows immediately that the heroine is being set up for a fall. The heroine places herself in some amazing situations and fell for some rather obvious scams. But as in all romance storylines, our hero will come to the rescue and they will drive off into the sunset to begin their HEA.

Vegas Knights is part of a series called BBW Erotic Romance-Big, Beautiful Women but I was a little taken aback when the storyline continues to punch at the fragile ego of a woman with low self-esteem due to her weight and size. The storyline had potential but I found myself shaking my head at far too many unbelievable situations encountered by a woman with both intelligence and beauty.
